JOURNEYS OF FAITH

From time to time at the Vines we've heard various people's stories ... their journeys — most recently, Renjini, Irene, and Ian and Karen, each highlighting significant faith moments.

The faith journey is somewhat of a paradox – sometimes it's deeply fulfilling; sometimes deeply challenging; sometimes joyful; sometimes painful; sometimes bringing unexpected changes.

My faith journey, though at times challenging and painful, has been imbued with music undergirded with expressions of God's love and faithfulness and Presence, attributes frequently underscored in Scripture.

In Isaiah we read, "But those who trust in the LORD for help will find their strength renewed. They will rise on wings like eagles; they will run and not get weary; they will walk and not grow weak." [Isa 40:31 – GNB]

And therein lies the paradox – at times we do feel a bit weary or a bit weak! But that doesn't negate the reality of God's Presence in our lives over the entirety of the journey.

Matthew's Gospel records Jesus' invitation: "Come to me, all of you who are tired from carrying heavy loads, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke and put it on you, and learn from me, because I am gentle and humble in spirit; and you will find rest. For the yoke I will give you is easy, and the load I will put on you is light." [Matt 11:28-30 - GNB]

There is clearly something about journeying with Jesus that enables us to find rest in the midst of all that happens and to do the things we are gifted to do. That raises a question: How do we respond to Jesus' invitation?

For members of our congregation who wish to give with flexibility on time and amount, The Vines church has set up a bank account with Westpac to receive such offerings. The details are:


