The 1st Samuel 1 & 2 readings for Sunday concentrate on Hannah and the role she will play in the ongoing history of Israel. There are many women in the Old Testament who play significant roles and are never part of our lectionary reading. For example, Tamar is mentioned in Matthew's genealogy but never comes up in the lectionary. Bathsheba committed adultery with David and is the mother of Solomon. She comes up in the lectionary as part of the Davidic story but in the genealogy she is referred to as the wife of Uriah: no name.

We will examine in detail the manner in which Hannah is portrayed how she responds to being the second wife, being barren, being treated suspiciously by the priest. Does she have anything to say to us today?

She lives in a time when women are the property of their husbands, when God is in control of fertility, and a woman is nothing if she is married and has no child. Her belief in God and faith that God will hear her prayer is strongly asserted in this story. When history is written by men, how come Hannah and the many other stories about women (many demonstrate how the women out-smart the men) are allowed to be present in Scripture?

BANK ACCOUNT – OFFERING


For members of our congregation who wish to give with flexibility on time and amount, The Vines church has set up a bank account with Westpac to receive such offerings. The details are:
