Mark 13:1-8 and Hebrews 10:11-25

We began this year full of hope, with great optimism. Except... that's not how it has turned out for some of us (or even many of us?)

When our optimism is stonewalled – when we are feeling tired and overwhelmed, and the hits of life are coming at us like a big pile of stones falling upon us – it can help to go back to basics and see what Jesus did. Mark 13:1-8 seems like yet another depressing tale of woe, where Jesus talks about the destruction of the Temple in Jerusalem. For the Jews, that was the end of the world as they knew it.

However, there's another message to hear. Far from predicting the imminent and apocalyptic end of the world, this passage brings hope for those of us who feel trapped behind high stone walls. For God is still here with us. We can be hopeful. We can look forward with hope as we live out our faith in the risen Christ. And in our other reading, from Hebrews 10, we have guidance for how we can live hope-filled lives.

I encourage you to let go of despair, and to claim this hope we have in Jesus.
