Three Parables of Grace

If you have time, I encourage you to read Luke 15 before worship. The Lost Sheep, the Lost Coin and the Lost Son, sometimes referred to as The Two Lost Sons, are parables of the unconditional love, or *Grace* of God.

The Title, "The Two Lost Sons" draws us to the behaviour of the elder son, compared with that of the younger son and the Father.

Today we will think about The Lost Son, or The Prodigal Son, who is not someone who returns, but an extravagant waster!

Rembrandt's painting, "The Return of the Prodigal Son", which hangs in the Hermitage in St. Petersburg, Russia, is the inspiration for the book with that name by The Dutch Catholic Priest, Henri Nouwen. His sub-title is: A story of Homecoming. Nouwen is one of my favorite writers of profound pastoral theology, whose book, "The Return of the Prodigal Son" has fed some of today's message.

If you Google Rembrandt's painting, you may experience some of its power, in the way the Parable is interpreted.

This parable raises many questions, not least of which is, "How do I react to actions and personalities that I find offensive and destructive?"

For members of our congregation who wish to give with flexibility on time and amount, The Vines church has set up a bank account with Westpac to receive such offerings. The details are:


