In the next few weeks, I will be focussing on the book of Colossians.

This is classed as one of the prison letters written when Paul was in jail. In these letters there is a focus on the glory of Christ and his headship of the church. We see this in Colossians where there is a great focus on Christ's role and the way he transforms our lives.

These are some problems, however. In this letter there are 48 words that appear only in Colossians and there is a hymnic form that really doesn't appear elsewhere. So, there is an argument that Paul did not write this letter. We know that often Paul worked with others, and it seems likely that Timothy was often involved in communicating to others on Paul's behalf. I would say that this letter is probably written on Paul's behalf by Timothy. It is a clear representation of Paul's thinking, even though it may have been written by another on Paul's behalf.

In all of this letter there are some strong themes. In chapter 2 and into chapter 3 the supremacy of Christ is the major theme and in the last part of the letter (ch 3 and 4) the conduct of the church is the major theme. We will look at themes in the second and third sermons I will share with you.

This week we will look at the underpinning of the letter. Vv15 - 23 are about the supremacy of Christ and we are given insight into the power of our unity in Christ and the gifts that arise from that. We see the power of God at work in Christ and then that power at work through us. Our union in Christ gives power to the work of Christ and then we are seeing that again in our lives as it is in Paul (vv24-29).

In this we are called to participate in the fullness of God's love and then share it in the community of the church. This is a powerful and wonderful joining of God's power in us and our redemption working out among us. If you have the opportunity, read chapter one again.
